We would like to inform you of the current situation in Berlín and the communities that you know. The measures that the government and the Ministry of Health have taken are as follows:

- 1- Crowds of more than 50 people are prohibited.
- 2- Schools and universities remain closed for 30 days, students receive study guides to study from home.
- 3- All restaurants and dining rooms have the service to take home only.
- 4- The municipal market must be closed at three o'clock in the afternoon to be disinfected.
- 5- Religious activities are suspended and only 50 people can be in the churches.
- 6- Resorts such as: the park and viewpoints remain closed for 15 days until new decisions
- 7- People in communities can go up to town to do their shopping and quickly return to their homes.
- 8- Transport units such as: buses, taxis and motorbike taxis are disinfected.

The recommendation to the entire population is that if it is not urgent to leave you must stay at home.

We thank God and the intercession of Saint Romero who in our country has not confirmed any case of this disease.
